



Alice V. Johnson Scholarship Program, 2011
Providing financial assistance for education to young Episcopalians

Alice V. Johnson left a portion of her estate in trust to the Episcopal Diocese of Massachusetts to provide assistance for young Episcopalians to continue their education after high school. She was generous and also concerned about young people. This legacy was given in honor of her parents, Charles A. and Emily A. Hanson, and her uncle, the Rev. Frits L. Anderson. Each year, The Alice V. Johnson Scholarship Program distributes the income from her legacy. The awards will range from \$1,000 to \$5,000.

All applicants must be active members of an Episcopal Church. Preference will be given to members of Grace Church, Everett MA, with a portion designated for members of Episcopal churches within the Mystic Valley Deanery. Selection criteria priorities include demonstrated commitment to Christian ideals, academic achievement, service to the community, character and promise as determined from letters of recommendation, and general level of need. In addition, applicants must be 30 years old or younger at time of application. Scholarships are for full or part-time undergraduate and vocational school students. Graduate students are not eligible for the scholarship.

Applicants must complete the application package, and must be accepted for admission by an accredited institution. Each award is for one year; re-application is necessary each year. The committee must receive all completed application packages, including the itemized checklist no later than May 1, 2011. These should be sent to:
